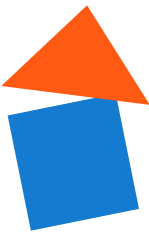
Why do we exist?

85% of a child's brain is developed by the age of five, laying the building blocks for their future. We never learn more, or faster than we do over these first five years. Getting these early foundations right is critical, especially for children growing up within the most challenging circumstances.



We know from research that before the age of 5, a child's home learning environment has the greatest impact upon their long-term development, all the way to the age of 18 – over and above any other factor.

Therefore, by empowering parents to nurture the learning that's happening at home, we're able to have the greatest impact upon long-term child outcomes, particularly those from disadvantaged backgrounds.



How does Boromi work?

Our Play Libraries include four different themes, carefully designed alongside the EYFS framework.



Step by step

1. At the start of term, Class Packs are delivered to settings (8 boxes per term – 2 of each theme)
2. Boxes are then free for families to borrow for a few days, take home and explore together
3. Each box comes equipped with a ready-to-go, modelled learning adventure that families can explore and enjoy whenever and wherever works best for them
4. At the end of each term boxes are then collected up and exchanged with new, exciting activities after the holidays!
